TOC = Test of Choice - you choose the test or tests you want to ride in the class/level.
Show management has the right to combine, add, or delete classes, as dictated by entries.

General Rules: This show will follow USEF rules and USDF guidelines. Please see the USEF Rule Book for complete explanation of sport horse in-hand & dressage competitions (<https://www.usef.org/compete/resources-forms/rules-regulations/rulebook>) and on the USDF and USEF scoresheets (<https://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/2019.asp>). Submit a separate entry for each horse/rider/handler.

Rules for Sport Horse In-Hand Classes: Will be scheduled before the Dressage Under-Saddle Classes. Horses will be shown in-hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. **USEF DR206.2:** "Bridles are mandatory on all horses age two or older in the competition ring, Bridles are ... permitted on yearlings. A bridle shall consist of a snaffle type bit (as pictured in Chapter DR, Subchapter DR-1, Figure 1A) with two reins and headstall with throatlatch. Reins must be attached only to bits as described in DR121.6. Noseband is optional. A split or single chain with a lead may be used instead of or in addition to reins; however, a lead shank is required if reins are placed over the horse's neck and the handler must hold the shank. Horses under the age of two may be shown in halters, except as noted above, and chain shanks may be used." Conservative attire is recommended for the handler. The handler may carry one whip. **USEF DR206.6:** "... helmets are required for all handlers, assistant handlers, and whip assistants of any age in in-hand classes."

Rules for Dressage Under-Saddle Classes: Will be scheduled after the Sport Horse In-Hand Classes. Current USDF, USEF, USEA, FEI and WDAA tests will be used. For the entire show, a horse may be ridden up to 4 times at Introductory Level only, up to 3 times at Training through Fourth Levels, and up to 2 times at Fourth Level and above. A horse/rider combination may ride a test only once; however, the horse/rider combination may ride

different tests in a class/level. A rider may ride more than one horse in the same test and the rider may compete more than one horse in a class/level. Proper attire for a Level 1 Competition and approved tack are required (see USEF Rulebook DR120 Dress); **show coats are optional**. ASTM/SEI certified helmet with fastened chin strap is required at all times when mounted on a horse (see USEF Rulebook DR120.6).

Arenas: Warm-up Arena is outdoor stone dust. Show Arena is 20m x 60m indoor with sand footing.

Discussion with the Judge: Each in-hand or ridden test will be followed by a 2-4 minute personal discussion with the judge, providing a mini clinic opportunity.

Awards:

- **Sport Horse In-Hand:** 1st – 6th place ribbons will be awarded for each class.
- **Dressage Under-Saddle:**
 - 1st – 6th place ribbons will be awarded for each class.
 - Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded to the two horse/rider combinations with the highest scores in each under-saddle rider-status division (AA, JYR, PRO). A minimum number of three division riders are required and a score of $\geq 55\%$ must be achieved.

Entries: Enter online at <http://www.frederickdressage.org/25-may-2019---plantation-valley.html>. On show day, bring check made out to **Catoctin Chapter of PVDA**, current **Coggins**, and **Hold Harmless Agreement** to the show. If a rider scratches after the original closing date or is a no-show, the ride fees are required. Mail to Leslie Raulin, 2027 Gapland Road, Jefferson, MD 21755.

Ride Times: Times will be emailed on or before May 22, 2019, using the email address provided on the entry; they will also be posted at <http://www.frederickdressage.org/shows-apr2019---oct2019.html>.

Special Requests: If special time considerations are needed, please indicate on the online entry form. These needs will be accommodated, if possible; however, show management wishes to make every effort to complete an individual class in a contiguous fashion. Show volunteers who are also competitors will be scheduled at the beginning of the show.

Directions to Plantation Valley Stables: From 70, take exit 42 Middletown/Myersville. Go South on 17. Follow 17 to Middletown. Go straight thru the light in Middletown. Proceed to Quebec School Road. Turn right on Quebec School Road. Cross Picnic Woods Road. Follow Quebec School Road to Marker Road. Turn right on Marker Road then left on Mountain Church Road. Farm is on the left. Park to the side of the entry drive.

This Show is a Frederick Area Dressage Show (FADS): Scores earned in this show in performance classes will be applied to FADS season-end championship awards. See FrederickDressage.org for more information.
