

Attention all competitors,

The 2021 FADS @ Wyndham Oaks shows will be run according to the following rules:

### **COVID Rules**

1. Wear a mask when on the farm grounds, unless riding. Bring your own mask.
2. Practice physical distancing of six feet with all people.
3. Wash hands frequently. Bring your own hand sanitizer.
4. The lounge is closed unless using the restroom; boarders use the barn restroom.
5. Spectators are allowed, but make your visit brief. However, do not bring spectators if it is raining to prevent crowding in the indoor arena. Masks and 6 feet apart important.

### **ENTRY Rules**

#### **How to enter:**

1. There will be a contactless entry policy. All electronic check-in, no numbers or check-in on-site.
2. Use the **FADS Online Entry Form** to enter the show.
3. Email your **Coggins** (within the past year), **Flu/Rhino verification** (within the past 6 months), and **Wyndham Oaks liability form** ([click here](#)) to [wyndhamoaks@gmail.com](mailto:wyndhamoaks@gmail.com).
4. Pay online with **PayPal** using [wyndhamoaks@gmail.com](mailto:wyndhamoaks@gmail.com).

#### **Other entry rules:**

1. Your entry will not be added to the show until Coggins, flu/rhino verification, liability release, and payment have been received. (This does not apply to boarders - we already have all this info.)
2. Show entries will be closed 24 hours after the show has filled.
3. There will be no refunds after the show is closed unless the show is cancelled.
4. We do not want trailers to stay on the farm for the day. Please let us know (in the special request box of entry) who you are trailering with so we can schedule your rides close together. Anyone wishing to ride their tests back-to-back to minimize your exposure please us me know.

### **EHV Rules**

1. BRING YOUR OWN WATER! The wash stalls will be closed. You MUST provide your own water for your horse.
2. Do not let horses greet or touch each other.
3. Do not share buckets, towels, lead ropes, halters, etc. between horses.
4. Contain your horse! **No grazing.**
5. WASH YOUR HANDS! Wash your hands after handling a horse or its equipment.
6. Bring a spare coat or shirt in case a strange horse gets saliva or nasal discharge on your clothes.
7. Do not linger on the grounds after your ride.
